<b>Study Trips</b>	Madrid, Córdoba, Granada, Seville. Local excursion within Segovia surroundings	
<b>Accommodations and meals</b>	Lodging and full board throughout the program in a single room in a home, including laundry. One student per family. Special accommodations provided.	
<b>Transportation</b>	Ground transportation for all included study trips, excursions and visits and roundtrip transfer from Madrid's airport to Segovia and back.
